- **\$75** Civic / Religious groups
- \$100 Non Profit / Religious organizations (excluding financial organizations)
- **\$200** Non Profit Revenues Greater Than \$1 Million

To calculate your investment when joining after January 31, divide the appropriate Annual Investment by 12. Multiply that amount by the number of months remaining in the current calendar year. Annual invoices are sent in December for the next calendar year.

Memberships renew automatically unless written non-renewal notice is provided to the chamber at least 30 days prior to our December billing cycle.
